Darin Perkins summarized the citations and proposed penalty as listed. The Commission unanimously approved issuing the citations and assessed the recommended penalty of \$3,000.00 on motion of Ms. Oster, second of Mr. Sanders.

Chairman Parker stated that he had intended to recuse himself from one of the items on the consent agenda and asked counsel for suggestions on how to reopen the consent item. Mr. Wade responded to the question. Mr. Parker moved to reconsider the consent agenda which was seconded by Ms. Oster and unanimously approved. Mr. Parker stated that for the record, he is recusing himself from consideration of renewal of self-insurance authority for the City of Scottsdale and made a motion to approve everything else on the consent agenda, which was seconded by Ms. Oster and unanimously approved. The Commission approved renewal of self-insurance authority for the City of Scottsdale on motion of Mr. Sanders, second of Ms. Oster. Mr. Parker did not participate in the vote regarding self-insurance renewal authority for the City of Scottsdale.
